

Congress Abstracts template and instructions:

Abstract presentation/structure is to be dictated as:

- The Abstracts should be submitted as **Word file**, with **one Abstract per page**.
- Abstracts must be **written in English**, they must be numbered, in the correct sequence
- If the **abstract is to be structured** it usually follows the following structure:
 - Background/Aims: What is the major problem that prompted the study?
 - Methods: How was the study performed?
 - Results: What are the most important findings?
 - Conclusion: What is (are) the most important conclusion(s)?
- Titles must be given in the sentence case** (not capital or lower case only)
- Authors: without titles or degrees, one forename must be given in full**
- Name of department(s), institution(s), city, country to which the work should be attributed.**
- Number of words: **250-350**
- The inclusion of one figure or table is a possible option.

Example of structured abstract:
